Total Servicios Financieros 'Total SF' was established in 1998 as a company specializing in financial leasing under the name Leasing Total. Total SF replicates the business model of its parent company Progreso Servicios Financieros, which was established in Chile in 1986. In 2021, Total SF received a license from the Superintendence of Banks of Peru to operate as a regulated, non-deposittaking entity and merged with its sister company, Factoring Total

Throughout its history, Total SF has developed a specialized financial product for small and medium-sized entrepreneurs 'SMEs', offering personalized attention to those often lacking alternative financing options. Total SF is dedicated to environmental protection, requiring all clients to sign and comply with an environmental commitment letter. This letter includes agreements to adopt measures for solid waste management, gas emissions control, wastewater reduction, and the protection of workers' health.

Total SF collaborates with SMEs, fostering their economic growth as well as the social development of their communities.

MSME: Trancilia

Marino Quispe founded Cecilia Martin Transport Company 'Trancilia' in Lima, Peru, in 1993. The company was established with the primary objective of specializing in cargo transportation, personnel transportation, and vehicle leasing.

Total SF started working with Trancilia in 2000 by providing a leasing loan for the acquisition of a truck. Since then, Total SF has become a vital ally to Marino and Trancilia, offering financing as well as financial and technical literacy. Total SF has enabled Trancilia to build a safe and durable fleet, supporting the company's growth and success. Over the last 20 years, Trancilia has developed a fleet of more than 20 vehicles, including buses, minibuses, tow trucks, dump trucks, and pickup trucks.
