PURPOSE AND OBJECTIVES

The objective of the Learning Journey is to provide an immersive experience that highlights the importance of financial inclusion.

Symbiotics Capacity Building is organizing the Learning Journey to Senegal, offering participants firsthand insights into the microfinance landscape and its impact on local economies.

The program focuses on financial inclusion for women entrepreneurs, exploring the challenges and opportunities faced by Micro-, Small and Mediumsized Enterprises (MSMEs) in Senegal and the broader impact of microfinance on livelihoods and sustainable business practices.

PROGRAM STRUCTURE

The Learning Journey will span from 7 to 11 April, 2025, incorporating a blend of workshops, field visits, and interactive sessions. Participants will engage with local financial service providers and interact with women-led micro-entrepreneurs.

The program is designed to be flexible, with specific activities and sessions tailored to emerging themes and insights in microfinance.

Throughout the week, participants will explore key themes:

- The role of microfinance in empowering micro-entrepreneurs
- » Challenges and opportunities in financial inclusion within urban and rural contexts
- The impact of financial literacy tools and digital innovation for MSMEs
- The role of impact investment firms in supporting financial inclusion through funding and Technical Assistance

- » Gain insights into Senegal's socio-economic and microfinance landscape.
- » Witness financial literacy tools in action in rural areas.
- » Get exposure to urban ecosystems through visits to financial services providers specialized in inclusion.
